

INVITATION TO BIDDERS

Sealed proposals will be received at the City of Maumee Office of the Director of Public Service, 400 Conant Street, Maumee, Ohio 43537, until 11:00 o'clock a.m. Local Time on Wednesday, June 30, 2021, at which time they will be opened and read immediately thereafter for the:

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: *The proposed work consists of the complete renovation of the existing pump station, including the following: demolish existing building; remove existing wet well top slab, remove existing pumps and piping; install new submersible pumps, new force main, and new guide rails; install new grinder unit, new wet well top slab, new valve access vault, new pump station control building, and generator; remove and replace existing access drive. The work also involves related electrical, mechanical, and site restoration items.*

Drawings, Specifications, and blank bid forms may be obtained at the above office of the OWNER upon payment of ONE HUNDRED TWENTY DOLLARS (\$120.00) NON-REFUNDABLE. Contract Documents can be shipped at the Bidder's expense for an additional shipping and handling fee (NON-REFUNDABLE). Contract Documents will be shipped as soon as possible after receipt of request and payment for such documents. **BIDS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED FROM BIDDERS LISTED ON THE OWNER'S OFFICIAL LIST OF PLANHOLDERS.** Checks shall be made payable to City of Maumee.

The estimated project cost is \$1,200,000.00.

A bid guarantee instrument must be submitted with the bid. The bid guarantee instrument shall be in the form of a Bid Guarantee and Contract Bond for the FULL AMOUNT of the bid OR a certified check, cashiers check, or irrevocable letter of credit for an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code.

The bid guarantee shall be made payable to the City of Maumee, Ohio, and is to be held as a guarantee that in the event the bid is accepted and a contract is awarded to the BIDDER, the contract will be duly executed and its performance properly secured. Bid security furnished in Bond form shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

The successful BIDDER(s) shall be required to furnish a Contract Bond in a sum of not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the total contract amount. The bond shall be that of an approved surety company authorized to transact business in the State of Ohio and shall be underwritten by a surety that is listed on the most current Department of the Treasury Circular 570, "Surety Companies Acceptable on Federal Bonds".

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio Products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the Ohio EEO Requirements shall be required.

Bidders must pay Prevailing Wage Rates for Lucas County, Ohio.

Each bid proposal must be made upon the blanks, or facsimiles thereof, furnished with the Contract Documents, and must be delivered to the City of Maumee, Office of the Director of Public Service, 400 Conant Street, Maumee, Ohio 43537, previous to 11:00 a.m. local time, on the date specified.

Each proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.

The City of Maumee reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bids

received, and to accept any bid that it deems most favorable.
