Conant Street & Bridge Closure for Arch Installation

MAUMEE, OH – The installation of two steel arches on Conant Street in Uptown Maumee is prompting the temporary closure of the Fort Meigs Memorial Bridge as well as a portion of Conant Street.

On Tuesday, February 27 Conant Street from the Anthony Wayne Trail to Broadway Street will close from 7 a.m. to 2 p.m. for the installation of the second arch in the uptown district. On-street parking restrictions in the 300 block of Conant Street will begin on the evening of Monday, February 26.

Drivers may use Gibbs, Ford, Key, and Broadway Streets during this closure.

The Fort Meigs Memorial Bridge will be open to local traffic only. Large trucks such as semi-trucks and box trucks will be prohibited from using the bridge on Tuesday, February 27.

On Wednesday, February 28 the Fort Meigs Memorial Bridge will close to all traffic from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. from Broadway Street in Maumee to the intersection of W. Front Street and U.S. Rt. 20 in Perrysburg.

Drivers may use SR 24, I-475, and US 25 as an alternate route.

We apologize for the inconvenience and will complete the projects as quickly and efficiently as possible.

Following completion of this work, three of the four arches will be installed as part of the uptown revitalization project.
