6. PETITION AND COMMUNICATIONS

A. Thank you from Project Iam City of Maumee Scholarship Letter from Sam Ghadban Family.

7. CONSENT CALENDAR

A. Recommendation from the City Administrator:

Approve the purchase of a new camera and access control system from Redshift Technology LLC for the Maumee Indoor Theater in an amount not to exceed \$13,323.00, and to authorize the City Administrator to approve all change orders not to exceed 10% of the total contract amount, and amend the 2021 IT-B Budget and appropriation measure to accommodate said purchase.

B. Recommendation from the City Administrator:

Approve the purchase of a new camera and access control system from Redshift Technology LLC for the Fire Station in an amount not to exceed \$35,895.00, and to authorize the City Administrator to approve all change orders not to exceed 10% of the total contract amount, and appropriate additional \$895.00 in the B Fund to accommodate said purchase.

C. Recommendation from the City Administrator:

Authorize retaining Dunright Building Services, Inc. to replace the five (5) front dining room windows at the Maumee Senior Center at the cost of \$11,389.00 and amend the IT-B budget and appropriation measure, and authorize the City Administrator to effectuate the agreement, and approve any additional change orders not to exceed 10% of the total contract amount.

D. Recommendation from the City Administrator:

Authorize a professional services agreement with the Mannik Smith Group to design a beaconed crosswalk on Cass Rd. and Thackeray Rd. in an amount not to exceed \$7,300, to authorize the City Administrator to approve all change orders not to exceed 20% of the total contract amount, and to appropriate the necessary funds from the SCM&R accounts.

E. Recommendation from the City Administrator:

Authorize a change order for professional services relative to Sewer Class II operator requirements in an amount not to exceed \$26,185.00, amend the 2021 budget and appropriations measure, appropriate the necessary funds, and authorize the City Administrator to approve any additional change orders not to exceed 10% of the total contract amount.

F. Recommendation from the City Administrator:

Authorize the purchase from Perrysburg Pipe of pipe and related materials for use in the Uptown Waterlines Project in an amount not to exceed \$40,000.00, and amend the 2021 budget and appropriations measure.

G. Recommendation from the City Administrator:

Retain the services of the JDI Group, Architects and Engineers for Design, Bidding, and Construction Phase Architectural and Engineering for a new bathroom facility at the Wolcott House Heritage Center and further authorize the City Administrator to negotiate and sign the contract/s for services in the amount of \$24,950 plus cost of \$800 per meeting and a 10% contingency based on the original bid pricing.

H. Recommendation from the Finance Director:

Authorize a contract with Accountemps for temporary Administrative Assistants in the Building & Zoning/Service Department and in the Utility Billing Department, and amend the 2021 budget and appropriations measure.

I. Recommendation from the City Administrator:

Authorize the purchase of 80 batteries for police portable radios at the sale price of \$122.25 per battery for a total price of \$9,780.00, authorize the City Administrator to approve any additional change orders not to exceed 10% of the total purchase amount, and amend the 2021 budget and appropriations measure.

J. Recommendation from the City Administrator:

Authorize an agreement with CIVICA CMI, to set up and provide software to transfer ticket data from eCitations into RMS and ODPS, in an amount not to exceed \$10,990.00, and to authorize the City Administrator to approve all change orders not to exceed 10% of the total contract amount, and amend the budget and appropriation measure.

K. Recommendation from the City Administrator:

Authorize a contract with for improvements to the Elizabeth Street pump station in an amount of \$1,215,196.00, and to authorize the City Administrator to approve all change orders not to exceed 10% of the total contract amount, and amend the budget and appropriate all funds necessary over and above original bid amount for the project.

L. Recommendation from the City Administrator:

Authorize City Administrator to enter into an agreement for professional services with Mannik & Smith for the purpose of applying for a TMACOG Grant for a Multi-Use Path and ODOT for a Highway Safety Improvement Program Grant in the total amount of \$18,200.00, to augment funding for the Anthony Wayne Trail project, and amend the 2021 budget and appropriations measure.

M. Recommendation from the City Administrator:

Authorize a contract with Beckett & Raeder, Inc., for professional services, architectural engineering and construction engineering of a pavilion on E. Broadway Street in an amount of \$49,643.26, and to authorize the City Administrator to approve all change orders not to exceed 10% of the contract amount, and amend the budget and appropriation measure.

N. Recommendation from the City Administrator:

Retain the services of the Feller Finch & Associates, of Maumee, Ohio to provide detail design and construction documents to pave the E. Harrison and White Street parking lot along and drive along the river and authorize the City Administrator to negotiate and sign the contract/s for services in the amount of \$16,000 plus cost of bidding, staking, and construction phase engineering, approve any and all change orders not to exceed 10% of the original bid pricing, and amend the 2021 budget and appropriations measure.

O. Recommendation from the City Administrator:

Authorize the findings and orders negotiated with the United States Environmental Protection Agency for correcting the City's Sanitary overflow.
