

ORDINANCE NO. 025-2023

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 113 OF THE MAUMEE CODIFIED ORDINANCES, IN ORDER TO UPDATE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CITY OF MAUMEE AS TO POSTING OF LEGISLATION AND OTHER NOTICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Maumee has previously adopted Chapter 113 of the Maumee Codified Ordinances and,

WHEREAS the State of Ohio changed its laws related to publication of ordinances;

WHEREAS, in order to update the requirements for the City of Maumee as to posting of legislation and other notices Chapter 113 should be amended to include the following revisions, additions and deletions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Maumee, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Chapter 113 of the Maumee Codified Ordinances be, and the same hereby is amended as follows:

CHAPTER 113  
Ordinances and Resolutions

113.01 Posting of legislation and notices.

113.02 Period of posting.

113.01 POSTING OF LEGISLATION AND NOTICES.

Unless otherwise specifically provided by the City Charter or by ordinance or resolution of Council, **a succinct summary of each municipal ordinance or resolution** and all ~~ordinances, resolutions,~~ notices, statements, orders, proclamations, and reports required to be published by the Charter of **the City of Maumee**, the Constitution of the State of Ohio, or legislation enacted by Council shall be **published by using one of the following methods: (1) Posting a copy thereof the same** in a conspicuous location in the Municipal Building and such other locations as may be deemed appropriate and designated by the Municipal Clerk; or **(2) On the official public notice web site established under section 125.182 of the Revised Code; or (3) On the web site and/or social media account of the City of Maumee.**

113.02 PERIOD OF POSTING.

~~Except for ordinances, resolutions or measures becoming effective as provided in Charter Article III, Section 9~~ Copies of ordinances, resolutions or other measures shall be posted for a period of not less than fifteen days **after passage by Council. Failure to post any ordinance, resolution or other measure shall not affect the validity of said ordinance, resolution or other measure.** ~~prior to the taking effect thereof. Ordinances, resolutions or measures becoming effective as provided in Article III, Section 9 of the Charter shall be posted for not less than fifteen days.~~


SECTION 2. Any ordinances, parts of ordinances or the Chapters of the Maumee Municipal Code in conflict herewith are hereby amended and repealed in part to reflect the foregoing changes;

SECTION 3. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary to preserve the public interest and for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Maumee, and more specifically to allow for the immediate update of the requirements for posting of legislation which will be a benefit for the citizens of Maumee so that the information as to the passage of legislation is readily available, wherefore this ordinance will go into immediate effect upon its adoption by council.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of council's committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the Charter of Maumee, Ohio.


