RESOLUTION NO. 003-2023

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO ENACT A 5.6 MILL TAX LEVY AND REQUESTING THE LUCAS COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE CITY AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY THAT LEVY, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 5705.03 and 5705.19 OF THE REVISED CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council finds that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the City and that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of that limitation for the purpose of operating and maintaining the Fire and Emergency Medical Services departments and all other purposes authorized by Ohio Revised Code 5705.19(I);

WHEREAS, this Council finds that it is necessary to create a levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation for an indefinite period of time; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 5705.03(B) of the Revised Code, in order to submit the question of a tax levy pursuant to Sections 5705.19 of the Revised Code, this Council must request that the Lucas County Auditor certify:(i) the total current tax valuation of the City (ii) the dollar amount of revenue, rounded to the nearest dollar that would be generated by the 5.6 mill additional levy specified in Section 1, (iii) the levy's rate expressed in dollars, rounded to the nearest dollar, for each one hundred thousand dollars of the Lucas County Auditor's appraised value, (iv) an estimate of the levy's annual collections, rounded to the nearest one thousand dollars, which shall be calculated assuming that the amount of the tax list of the taxing authority remains through the life of the levy the same as the amount of the tax list for the current year, and (v) any other certifications required to be made pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.03(B)(2) to Maumee; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 5705.03(B), upon receipt of a certified copy of a resolution of this Council declaring the necessity of the tax, stating its purpose, whether it is an additional levy or a renewal or a replacement of an existing tax, and the Section of the Revised Code authorizing its submission to the electors, and requesting such certification, the County Auditor is to certify the total current tax valuation of the City and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the proposed levy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City Maumee, County of Lucas, Ohio, that:

Section 1. <u>Declaration of Necessity</u>. This Council declares that it is necessary to create, for a continuing period of time, an additional five and six tenths (5.6) mill property tax for each one dollar of taxable value, outside of the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of operating and maintaining the Maumee Fire and Emergency Medical Services departments and all other purposes authorized by Ohio Revised Code 5705.19(I) and that it intends to submit the question of that additional tax levy to the electors at an election on May 2, 2023. If approved, the 5.6 mill additional tax would be first placed on the tax list and duplicate for the tax year 2023, for collection commencing in calendar year 2024. The tax shall be levied upon the entire territory of the City of Maumee, Lucas County Ohio. Maumee has territory within Lucas County Ohio only. The ballot measure shall be submitted to the entire territory of Maumee. Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.03 and 5705.19 authorize the submission of the question of this tax.

Section 2. <u>Request for Certification</u>. This Council requests the Lucas County Auditor to certify to it (i) the total current tax valuation of the City (ii) the dollar amount of revenue, rounded to the nearest dollar that would be generated by the 5.6 mill additional levy specified in Section 1, (iii) the levy's rate expressed in dollars, rounded to the nearest dollar, for each one hundred thousand

dollars of the Lucas County Auditor's appraised value, (iv) an estimate of the levy's annual collections, rounded to the nearest one thousand dollars, which shall be calculated assuming that the amount of the tax list of the taxing authority remains through the life of the levy the same as the amount of the tax list for the current year, and (v) any other certifications required to be made pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.03(B)(2) to Maumee.

Section 3. <u>Certification and Delivery of Resolution to County Auditor</u>. The Clerk of Council is directed to deliver or cause to be delivered a certified copy of this Resolution to the Lucas County Auditor.

Section 4. <u>Compliance with Open Meeting Requirements</u>. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council or of its committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

Section 5. <u>Captions and Headings</u>. The captions and headings in this Resolution are solely for convenience of reference and in no way define, limit or describe the scope or intent of any Sections, subsections, paragraphs, subparagraphs or clauses hereof.

Section 6. <u>Declaration of Emergency</u>: <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that this Resolution is required to be immediately effective so that it can be timely filed with the Lucas County Auditor, in order that the question of the placement of the 5.6 mill levy for the purpose stated in Section 1 may be submitted to the electors at an election on May 2, 2023; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
